- **First A.M.E. Church** - is a community partner that provides REW Ministries with in-kind donations, facility and education space in a safe environment.
- **FAME Outreach and Community Development Corporation 'FOCDC'** – A mentoring program for young ladies between the ages of 16-18, REW Ministries has partner with these young ladies in various community service projects to enable them to complete their required 40 hours of community service (feeding the homeless, rest homes visitations etc.).
- **Becoming a Responsible Teen (BART)** - is a culturally appropriate, HIV prevention curriculum designed especially for adolescents in non-school, community-based settings.
- **Youth for Positive Action** - is an evidence base program that teaches youth positive thoughts that lead to positive actions which lead to positive outcomes. Substance abuse prevention through proper education and training.
- **The Children Defense Fund (CDF)** - Freedom Schools program provides summer and after-school enrichment through a model curriculum that supports children and families around five essential components: High quality academic enrichment; Parent and family involvement; Social action and civic engagement; Intergenerational servant leadership development; Nutrition, health and mental health.
- **Las Vegas Promise (LVP)** - mission is to advance educational opportunity equity, and excellence for Las Vegas' children and youth through community-based research, academic programs, leadership development, and civic engagement.
- **Three Square** - provides wholesome food to hungry people, while passionately pursuing a hunger-free community.
- **Faith Organizing Alliance** - focus is to educate and train individuals, faith based/civic leaders and other community organizations on civic engagement and public policy as it pertains to voter's rights and responsibility.
